Mayor Glenn Wunderlich presided

1. Council Members present: Steve Nelson, Dave Widhalm, Angi Kirkbride. absent: Janelle Nelson

Mayor Wunderlich brought the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

2. Mayor Wunderlich led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Mayor Wunderlich called for any corrections or additions to the January 10, 2022, Regular Council meeting minutes. Alderman S. Nelson made a motion to approve the minutes from the January 10, 2022, meeting. Alderman Widhalm seconded. Mayor Wunderlich called for a vote. Motion carried unanimously.

4. Public Comment.

Erik Nelson raised concern about the residents of the Town of Valier funding the Port Authority through taxes and never taking advantage of the Port Authority services.

5. Police Report

Some of the highlights include: 4 traffic complaints, 0 noise complaint, 35 citations issued, 4 traffic crashes, 70 residential security checks, 119 business security checks. 37 other security checks, 9 agency assists, 2 dog complaints, 2 arrests, 5 civil papers served. 0 livestock inspections, 2 vehicle inspections, 0 drug complaints, 13 bar checks, 2 theft calls. 3 assault, 4 alarms, 11 medical emergency, 0 burglaries, 11 burn permits, 3 fire calls 12 motorist assists, 3 disturbance calls, 13 welfare checks, 0 scam, 3 suspicious persons, 0 vandalism, 0 animal cruelty, 0 trespassing, 0 harassment, 3 suspicious vehicles, 0 abandoned vehicles.

6. Craig Nowak update the council on the status of the wastewater project and all the funding has been secured.

7. Public works report.

The town pumped 1,054,100 gallons of water for the month, for an average of 34,003 gallons per day. Bulk water sold 66,410 gallons for the month. The water sample was good for the month. The water wells are about average for this time of year.




Next regular council meeting will be held on Monday, March 14, 2022, at 7:00 pm at the Valier Civic Center.
