Mayor Wunderlich brought the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

2. Mayor Wunderlich led the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Mayor Wunderlich called for any corrections or additions to the November 8, 2021, Regular Council meeting minutes. Alderman Widhalm made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 8, 2021, meeting. Alderwoman Kirkbride seconded. Mayor Wunderlich called for a vote. Motion carried unanimously.

5. Police Report

Some of the highlights include: 10 traffic complaints, 1 noise complaint, 33 citations issued, 5 traffic crashes, 19 residential security checks, 49 business security checks, 23 other security checks, 17 agency assists, 11 dog complaints, 5 arrests, 3 civil papers served, 4 livestock inspections, 2 vehicle inspections, 2 drug complaints, 10 bar checks, 11 theft calls, 1 assault, 7 alarms, 1 medical emergency, 4 burglaries, 4 burn permits, 5 fire calls 9 motorist assists, 1 disturbance call 12 welfare checks, 1 scam, 10 suspicious persons, 1 vandalism, 1 animal cruelty, 1 trespassing, 1 harassment, 5 suspicious vehicles, 4 abandoned vehicles.

6. The First reading of ordinance title 9-1-2 rule 18 was read by the mayor. Alderman S. Nelson made a motion to accept the amended ordinance as read. Alderman Widhalm seconded. Mayor Wunderlich called for a vote. Motion carried unanimously.
7. The mayor called for an open discussion on the junk vehicle letters. Alderman S. Nelson made a motion to accept the junk letter pending the town attorney's review. Alderwoman Kirkbride seconded. Mayor Wunderlich called for a vote. Motion carried unanimously.

8. Public works report.

The town pumped 945,300 gallons of water for the month, for an average of 30,413 gallons per day. Bulk water sold 32,900 gallons for the month. The water sample was good for the month. The water wells are about average for this time of year.


11. Adjourn.
