RESOLUTION #197

A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN:

WHEREAS, under the Montana Code Annotated 7-4-4201 Salary of Officers. The Council shall determine by ordinance or resolution the salaries and compensation of elected and appointed city officers and all city employees, and

WHEREAS, after review the Town Council has determined by vote at the Council Meeting held September 12, 2022 the salaries of the Mayor and Aldermen should be increased and

WHEREAS, an increase in salaries may attract more future candidates for office,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the salaries of the Mayor and Aldermen shall be increased as follows:

Mayor \$500.00 per month or \$6000.00

Aldermen \$200.00 per month 2400.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the salary increases shall become effective September 26, 2022.



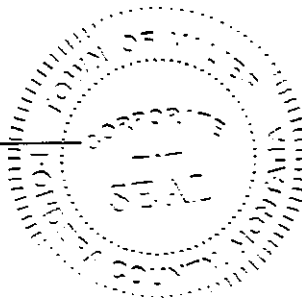


